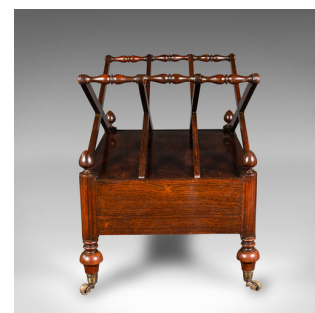
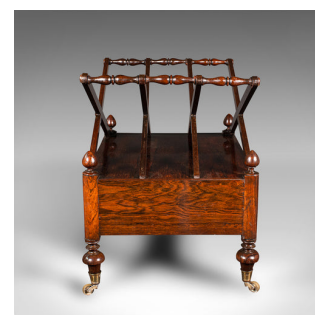


Antique Canterbury Rack, English, 3 Section, Magazine, Newspaper Stand, Regency

This is an antique Canterbury rack. An English, rosewood three sectioned magazine or newspaper stand, dating to the Regency period, circa 1820.

- Raised upon squat cupped legs and riding smoothly upon brass castors to each corner
