This is a set of 8 antique dining chairs. An English, mahogany and leather seat with Chippendale revival taste, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Select stocks to the frame show fine grain interest and deep russet hues
- Vibrant red leather over traditionally stuffed drop-in cushions with minor ageing
- Excellent Chippendale revival taste with delightful pierced seat backs
- Graced with the typical 'Chippendale' ears to the canted corners of the cresting rail
- Exquisite detail accentuates the back splat with scroll and ribbon motif
- Side rails host diamond shaped patera in relief against mottled frieze
- Elegant, sinuous arms with shaped rests over serpentine supports for the pair of carvers
 - Superb broad knees with decorative scroll forms, lobed apron uniting each side
 - Standing upon cabriole front legs terminating in fascinating ball and claw feet
