- In tasteful bottle green, the skiver is tooled and embossed
- Set within the lid reverse, a matching leather cushioned pad with pen slides
- Five document compartments with an offset square tray ideal for a small ink well
- Two delightfully petite drawers dressed with circular brass pulls
