- Quality tooled and embossed leather skiver across two sections
- Brass shield to lid in unmarked condition, ideal for personalisation
- \bullet Case fascia finished with a brass shield lock escutcheon in working order, key present
 - Dressed with a pair of brass recessed cup handles in the campaign manner
 - Useful side drawer held in place by a removable interior pin
 - Suite of compartments to the interior for storage of papers, pens and other items
 - Each half of the skiver lifts to gain access to a documents compartment
 - Hidden panel to upper skiver box hides a pair of shallow drawers
