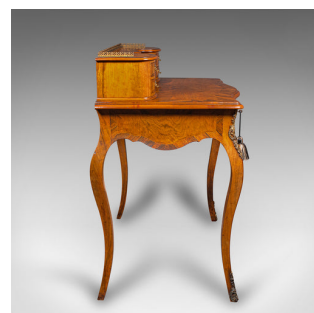


Antique Bonheur Du Jour, French, Walnut, Ladies Writing Desk, Victorian, C.1900

This is an antique bonheur du jour. A French, walnut ladies writing desk, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Sumptuous colour and delightful figuring to this fine desk
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Walnut and Burr walnut stocks present fine grain interest
- Dashing caramel hues beam beneath a quality wax polish finish
- Low back rest adorned with brass gallery rails over two banks of small drawers
- Each drawer dressed with small brass pulls, decorated in ornate manner
- Superb marquetry enhances the writing surface, with book matched centrepiece
- Shaped front apron hosts a generous lower drawer, with inset working lock — key present

- Bowed hipline hosting long ormolu mounts with golden tonality
- Finished back affords central room placement
- Standing upon a quartet of slender cabriole legs with splayed toes
