- Walnut and Burr walnut stocks present fine grain interest
- Dashing caramel hues beam beneath a quality wax polish finish
- Low back rest adorned with brass gallery rails over two banks of small drawers
- Each drawer dressed with small brass pulls, decorated in ornate manner
- \bullet Superb marquetry enhances the writing surface, with book matched centrepiece
- \bullet Shaped front apron hosts a generous lower drawer, with inset working lock key present
 - Bowed hipline hosting long ormolu mounts with golden tonality
 - Finished back affords central room placement
 - Standing upon a quartet of slender cabriole legs with splayed toes
