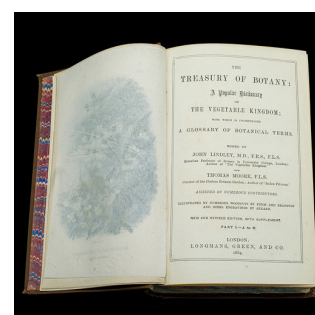


Antique Treasury Of Botany, Vol 1&2, English Language, Reference Book, Victorian
