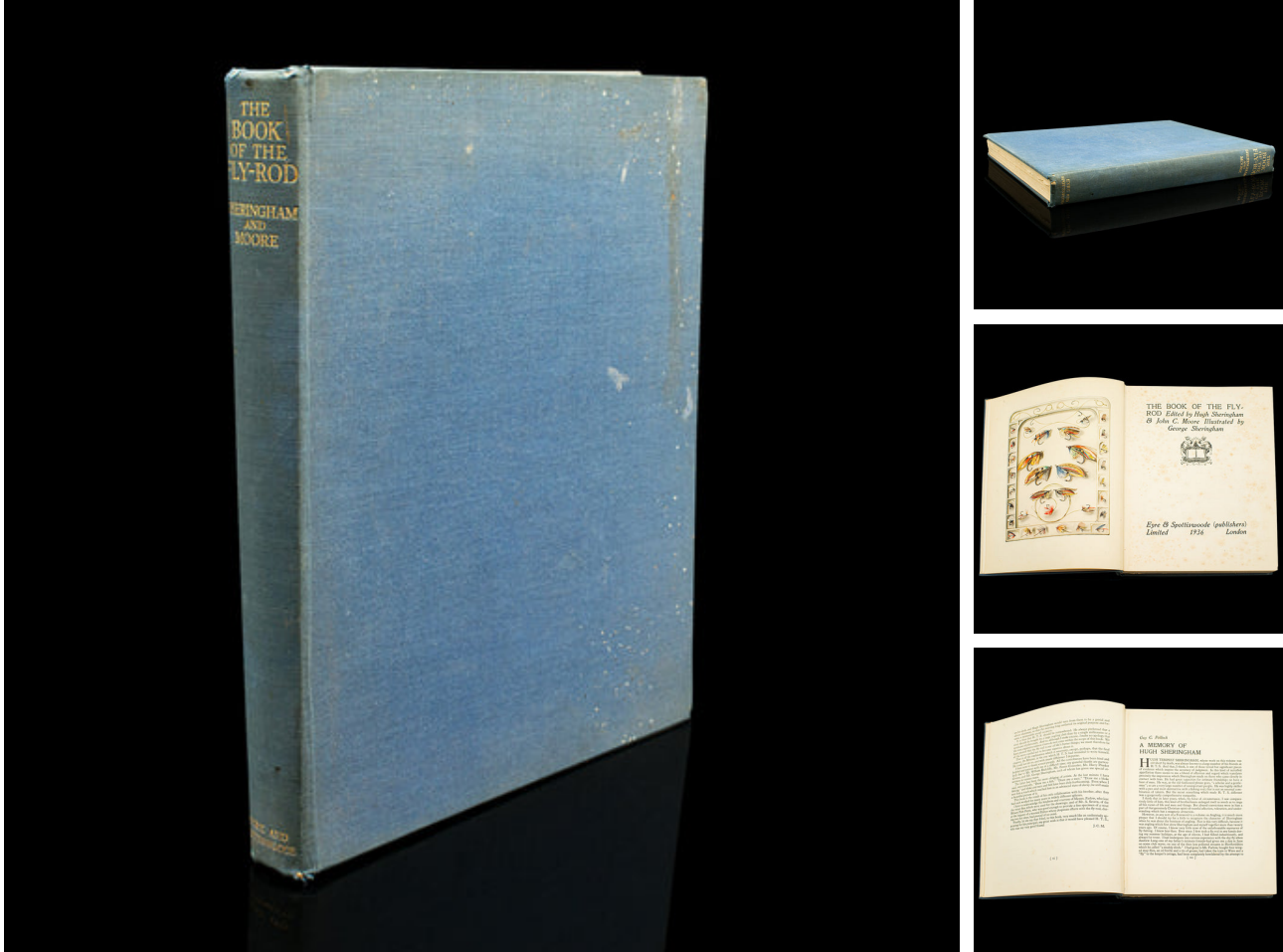


## Vintage Reference, The Book of the Fly Rod, Sheringham & Moore, English, 1936
