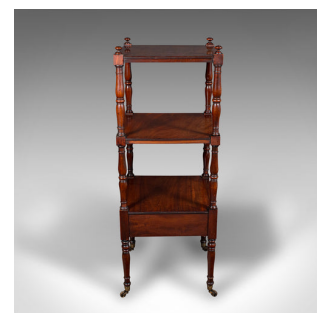


Antique 3 Tier Whatnot, English, Open Display Stand, Late Georgian, Circa 1800
