This is an antique desktop writing slope. An English, burr walnut and brass correspondence box, dating to the mid Victorian period, circa 1860.

- An attractive and delightfully appointed slope for the desktop
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good condition
- Striking burr walnut stocks present superb grain interest
- Rich caramel hues dance beneath a wax polish finish

 \bullet Domed stationery compartment dressed with a brass twist latch $\mbox{ escutcheon} - \mbox{ key}$ present

- Turning the key operates the domed lid and releases the fold-out writing slope
- Within the stationery compartment, a pair of smaller compartments flank a quintet of small document sleeves
 - Two delightful glass ink wells sit neatly within a brass square mount
 - Striking indigo coloured velvet writing slope embossed with a superb pattern
 - Upper section of the slope opens, revealing a recessed pair of document slides
