- Opening reveals a suite of skivers, arcading to pigeon holes and small drawers
- Skiver pulls out to a comfortable working height of 75.5cm (29.75")
- High quality, triple tooled and embossed skivers with inset compartments to the outer pair
- In rich blue leather with monogram, the central skiver can be adjusted for angle on a rack
- Bank of small drawers with glorious bird's eye maple fascia, above a faux drawer panel
- Set of four drawers set within the apron, two wide over a smaller pair and dressed with brass pendants
