This is a vintage recumbent lion figure. A Continental, bronze animal sculpture after Antoine-Louis Barye, dating to the late 20th century, circa 1970.

- After the works of Barye (1796 1875), a renowned animalier and sculptor
- Dressed to the base with a protective leather pad
