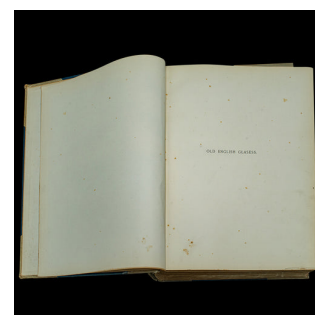


Antique Reference Book, Old English Glasses, Hartshorne, History, Victorian

This is an antique reference book, Old English Glasses. An English language, bound historical title by Albert Hartshorne, published in the late Victorian period, 1897.

Full title: Old English Glasses. An Account of Glass Drinking Vessels in England, from Early Times to the End of the Eighteenth Century.

An English archaeologist, Albert Hartshorne (1839 - 1910) studied at Westminster School before seeking further education in France and Germany. A son of an antiquarian, Hartshorne was twice secretary of the Royal Archaeological Institute of Great Britain and Ireland, editor of the Archaeological Journal and a fellow of the Society of the Antiquaries of London.
