This is an antique cased microscope. An English, enamelled metal and brass scientific instrument by J. Swift & amp; Son of London, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Black enamelled stand contrasting with the bright polished brass instrument
- Quality carry box shows rich caramel hues with inset lock key absent
- Extending eyepiece tube over a rack and pinion main focus rail
- Three slot nosepiece resides above a square stage with rotary slide holders
- Stage engraved with a fine measuring grid
- Trio of accessory objective lenses resting within the case
- Bright, good quality rotating mirror beneath the slide holder
- Engraved to the rear with J. Swift & Dondon maker's mark
- Dealer plaque to case for A. Franks of Deansgate, Manchester
