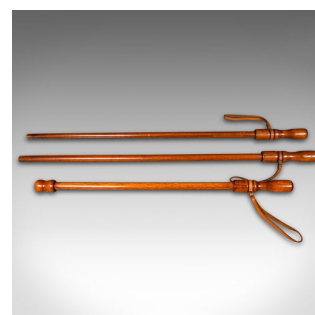
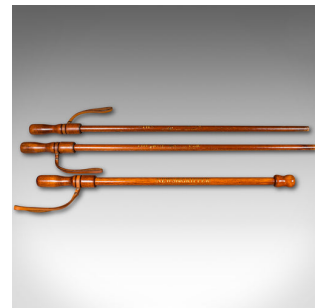


3 Vintage Newspaper Grippers, English, Beech, Library Reading Aid, Circa 1980
