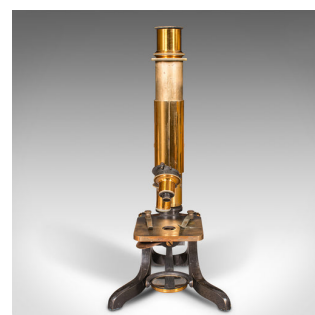
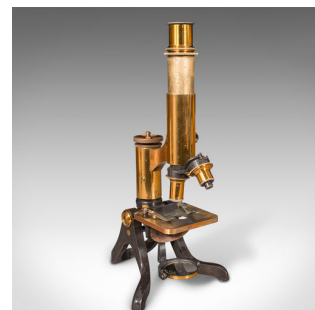


Antique Scholar's Microscope, English, Brass, Scientific Instrument, Victorian
