This is an antique pier display cabinet. An English, burr walnut and boxwood inlaid glazed bookcase or china cupboard, dating to the Regency period, circa 1820.

- Majestic craftsmanship with exquisite colour and figuring
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Select burr walnut stocks impress with superior grain interest
- Sumptuous caramel hues dazzle beneath the wax polish finish
- Distinctive profile with demi-lune corners hosting pilasters over a plinth base
 - Upper fascia adorned with striking marquetry, the foliate motif in boxwood and apple wood
- Generously glazed cabinet door dressed with a brass lock escutcheon – key present
- Eye-catching ormolu beading accentuates the door, further enhanced with boxwood stringing
- Cabinet interior resplendent in the original velvet upholstery, across a pair of shelves
- Generous depth accommodates larger volumes, or prized ornaments
- Attractive pilasters framing the door finished with ebonised terminus
