- Spoon back rest enhanced with a striking carved cresting rail
- Superb relief carvings adorn the frame edge with aplomb

- Superb manchette arms terminate in fascinating ram's head masks
- Deeply cushioned seat resides at a comfortable height of 46cm (18")
- Delightfully comfortable, stuffed in the traditional manner over a robust frame
