This is a tall antique music stand. An English, oak adjustable recital rest, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1880.

- Superb range of adjustment placing the rest at your desired height

• Appealing pierced fretwork decorates the sheet music stand, with bronze rotating stoppers

- Great depth to the well-sized rest, easily accommodating larger sheets and books
- Set neatly within the frame, the rest adjusts upon a toothed ratchet guide
- Finished with a bronze adjustable screw to secure the rest upon the pole
- Slender support stand topped with a charming finial
- Turned and cupped form to the lower mount with twist reeded finish
- Distinctive trio of legs to the base accentuated with a small finial to each toe
