This is an antique fold over tea table. An English, mahogany occasional table, dating to the William IV period, circa 1835.

- Beautifully presented table with a fine rotating and extending top
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in very good order
- Select stocks present fine grain interest throughout
- Rich caramel hues dance beneath a wax polish finish
- Fold over top rotates and extends upon brass hinges to accommodate four persons
- Set within the frame, an internal storage box accessible with the top at 90 degrees
- Striking shaped apron buttresses, with scrolled leaf relief decor to the front fascia
- Inset field panel apron to front, accentuated with cockbeading
- Octagonal chamfered support column tapers gently towards the table top
- Superb demi-lune bulb unites the column with the hyperboloid base
- Standing upon a fine set of four lion paw feet with striking detail
