This is a large antique steamer trunk. An American, leather and brass bound shipping chest, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Fine example of decorative furniture, with a generously sized interior
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good original order
- Lightly time worn leather with dark brown hues and press stud trim
- Bound to the corners with brass caps for reassuring strength
- Pleasingly dressed in leather to all surfaces of the generously proportioned form
- Bold brass scallop latch to centre with inset lock – key absent
- Further dressed with a pair of slide clips holding the lid securely
- Large interior finished with a blue cotton lining, in clean order
- Finished with leather carriage straps adorn either end
- Remnants of travel labels adds a dash of period detail
- Maker's mark to lid for 'London' by the New York Trunk & Bag Co
