




Vintage Book, The Swiss Family Robinson, English, Fiction, Johann Wyss, C.1930

Written by the Swiss author Johann David Wyss (1743 - 1818), The Swiss Family Robinson was inspired by Robinson Crusoe (by Daniel Defoe) from a century earlier. A tale intended to teach the writer's children morality and family values, the titular family is shipwrecked en route to Australia and survive upon a remote island until a rescue attempt.
