This is a set of 5 antique dining chairs. A Scottish, rosewood buckle back seat, dating to the William IV period, circa 1835.

- Carved acanthus bar splats unite the mid point of the distinctive back rest
- Each cushion dressed in a tasteful champagne gold upholstery
- Cushions finished with a tasteful brocade trim in light gold
- Traditionally stuffed cushions set at a comfortable height of 46cm (18")
- Superb tulip bulb carvings adorn the knees, tapering below to the circular foot
- Splayed rear legs of square section form cascade from the back rest
