- Graced with deep caramel hues to the top, apron and frame
- Comfortably seat 6 to 8 diners with a kneehole height of 63cm (24.75")
- Four plank top with cleated ends and deftly chamfered corners
- Delightful carved decor to the apron, with bold turned and gadrooned knees
- Raised upon a quartet of turned legs with square feet, united by stretcher rails

This is a generously sized antique refectory table, offering high visual appeal and useful proportion. Solid joints and construction, delivered ready for the home.
