This is a large vintage carved chest. A Burmese, solid teak decorative trunk, dating to the Art Deco period, circa 1930.

- Profusely decorated, with wonderfully substantial stocks throughout
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order throughout
- Solid teak presents rich caramel hues and fine grain interest
- Protective, removable glass top for use as a distinctive coffee table
 - Stout top with gently rolled edge hosts a striking carved frieze with foliate medallions
- Held securely with a large, engraved brass clasp to the fascia
- Opens to reveal a generous interior, replete with lidded candle box
- Through dovetail joints to the corners reveal the impressively thick 1" stocks
- Set of four drawers along the lower edge with foliate carved fascia
- Fascinating pair of hidden drawers reside behind the middle two drawer fronts
- Each outer drawer dressed with brass drop handles
