This is a vintage dresser base. An English, oak side cabinet in Georgian revival taste, dating to the late 20th century, circa 1970.

- Traditional appeal with a fine Georgian revival taste

- Fine oak stocks present appealing grain interest throughout
- Of country house finish, with eye-catching rich caramel hues
- Of useful proportion with an arrangement of three drawers and cabinets
- Drawer fronts dressed with brass drop handles over bat wing backplates
- Trio of doors open upon traditional H-shaped butterfly hinges
- Finished with panelled door fascia and secured with twist latches
- Opening as a pair and a single door, with full-width shelf to the interior
- Panelled reverse for presentation, with 14 board finish
- Standing upon a quartet of block feet beneath a flared apron
