This is an antique Sutherland table. An English, burr walnut gate-leg 4-seat occasional table, dating to the early Victorian period, circa 1840.

- Impressively figured oval table in the traditional Sutherland form
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Quality burr walnut presents superb grain interest, with book-matching to top
- Rich caramel hues radiate a pleasingly warm vibrance
- Of useful breakfast table or tea service proportion when extended
- Striking oval top with scalloped edge detail to each corner
- Wide drop leaves extend the seating area comfortably for four
- In the folded position, the narrow profile ideal for storing in the smaller room
- Articulated gate legs provide support for each leaf at 90 degrees
- Elegantly turned baluster legs united with a stretcher rail between prominent cabriole feet
 - Each foot decorated with blind fretwork carving and scrolled toes
