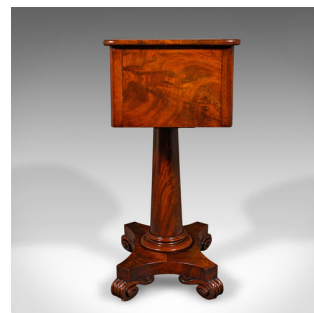
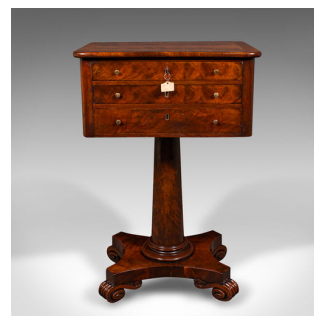


Small Antique Ladies Correspondence Table, English, Flame, Writing, William IV

This is a small antique ladies correspondence table. An English, flame mahogany writing table, dating to the William IV period, circa 1835.

- Fine suite of functions and storage across an appealing, compact form
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Select flame stocks present delightful grain interest throughout
- Deep russet and caramel hues dance beneath a wax polish finish
 - Arrangement of three drawers to the fascia, each configured to individual requirements
- Upper drawer boasts a leather skiver set upon a hinged slope, with storage space beneath
- Middle drawer outfitted with pen trays to each side, framing central storage
- The lowest drawer of full width form, ideal for larger papers or notebooks
- Each drawer dressed with pairs of small brass circular pulls
- Matched inset locks across all three fascia — in working order, key present
- Gently tapering support column of stout proportion with collared mount
