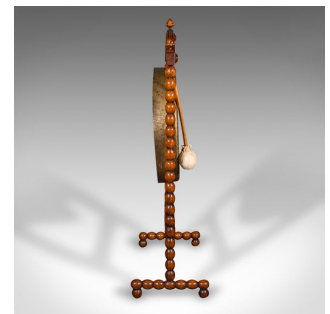


Antique Country House Dinner Gong, English, Bobbin Turned Oak, Victorian, C.1890

This is an antique country house dinner gong. An English, bobbin turned oak chime frame, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1890.

- Standing upon a pair of shaped trestle legs with four ball feet
