- Select stocks present warm caramel hues and fine grain interest
- Superb fascia offers a pair of drawers with blind pulls — locks untested, key absent
- Well suited for occasional correspondence, hallway placement or within a living room
- Prominent relief carved sash bouquet set upon a central frieze
- Front and side aprons adorned with attractive fretwork over an ebonised ground
- Quality mahogany drawer boxes with impressive dovetail joints
- Each corner accentuated with a quatrefoil motif, repeating upon the leg
- Pierced fretwork brackets unite each leg to the apron in the Chippendale manner
- Offers a comfortable kneeheight of 61.5cm (24.25")
