This is an antique 5-draw telescope. An English, brass terrestrial or astrological refractor by Broadhurst, Clarkson & Co, dating to the Edwardian period, circa 1910.

- Clear, bright objective lens with a generous diameter of 60mm (2.25")
- The flared eyepiece finished with concentric ring turning
- Engraved to the penultimate barrel for Broadhurst, Clarkson & Co of London
- Dealer engraving to the opposite side for H Salanson & Co of Bristol and Cardiff
