This is an antique combination games table. A Middle Eastern, inlaid olivewood and exotic wood metamorphic chess and backgammon table, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900.

- Strikingly ornate, with an exceptional metamorphic form to host a multiple of favourite games
- Displays a desirable aged patina, slight loss to the top commensurate with age
- Olivewood stocks profusely accentuated with bone and wooden inlay
- Rich caramel hues with contrasting saffron and amber colouring
- Fascinating upper, with rotating motion and dual folding action
- Upon rotation, access is granted to a generous card and counter storage box
- Initial fold reveals a crushed velvet card table in a delightful emerald green
- Half of the card baize folds upon itself, revealing the exquisite chess table
- One final folding action opens out fully to show the backgammon board
