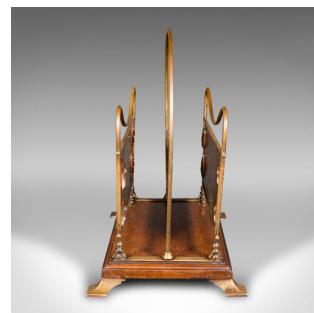


Antique Newspaper Rack, French, Brass, Copper, Walnut, Magazine Stand, Victorian
