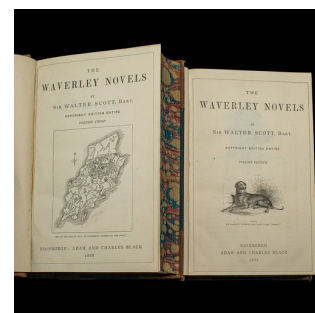
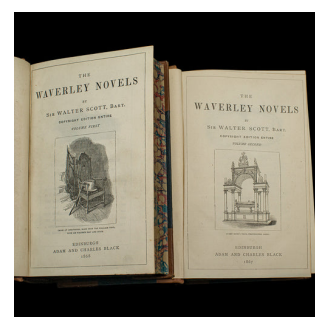


Antique 4 Vols, Waverley Novels, Walter Scott, Scottish, Literary Set, Victorian
