This is an antique cigar humidor. A Continental, ebonised mahogany and gilt metal Petit Corona case, dating to the mid Victorian period, circa 1860.

- Beguiling humidor, with a profusion of intricate brightwork
- Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order
- Superb ebonised stocks presenting a deep, lustrous finish
- Quality gilt metal presents ebullient golden tones throughout
- Classical motif adorns the exterior, with a surmount Cherub gracing the cutter compartment
- Accessed by a small sliding clasp, the cutter compartment measuring an inch deep
- Ornate pierced fretwork escutcheon to the fascia with inset lock – key present
- Corners further accentuated with profuse scroll and beaded mounts
- Opening the lid released the pair of front doors to reveal the humidor trays
