Quality gilt metal presents ebullient golden tones throughout

class="p1">Classical motif adorns the exterior, with a surmount Cherub gracing the cutter compartment

class="p1">Accessed by a small sliding clasp, the cutter compartment measuring an inch deep

class="p1">Ornate pierced fretwork escutcheon to the fascia with inset lock - key present

class="p1">Corners further accentuated with profuse scroll and beaded mounts

class="p1">Opening the lid released the pair of front doors to reveal the humidor
