This is an antique cigar humidor. A Continental, ebonised mahogany and gilt metal Petit Corona case, dating to the mid Victorian period, circa 1860.

<li class="p1">Superb ebonised stocks presenting a deep, lustrous finish

<li class="p1">Quality gilt metal presents ebullient golden tones throughout

<li class="p1">Classical motif adorns the exterior, with a surmount Cherub gracing the cutter compartment

<li class="p1">Accessed by a small sliding clasp, the cutter compartment measuring an inch deep

<li class="p1">Ornate pierced fretwork escutcheon to the fascia with inset lock – key present

<li class="p1">Corners further accentuated with profuse scroll and beaded mounts

<li class="p1">Opening the lid released the pair of front doors to reveal the humidor trays
